### Guidelines for Documentation of Occupational Therapy ...

OTs may document in either an electronic medical record, which is a patient chart or record that is completely computer based, or written format. Written documentation needs to be legible and neat...

### Guidelines for Documentation of Occupational Therapy

Crafting the Ideal OT Note Subjective (S). Each note should tell a story about your patient, and your subjective portion should set the stage. Try... Objective (O). The objective section of your evaluation and/or SOAP note is often the longest. This is almost certainly... Assessment (A). The ...

### Guidelines for Documentation of Occupational Therapy

The two most important PT/OT documentation requirements are demonstrating that care is (1) medically necessary and (2) skilled. Care is regarded as “skilled” only if it is at a level of complexity and sophistication that requires the services of a therapist or an assistant supervised by a therapist.

OT Rules As mandated by the Texas Occupational Therapy Practice Act, the OT Board adopts rules to govern the practice of occupational therapy in the state. New rules, amendments to existing rules, and repeal of rules are adopted in response to developments and trends in occupational therapy practice or when mandated by legislative action.

### Appropriate Use and Documentation of Therapeutic ...

To ensure the clinical record contains the necessary information to support the primary. functions of record keeping, OTs must consider their scope of practice, the nature of the client-therapist. relationship, the objectives and risks of the intervention as well as the expectations of the client.

### Occupational Therapy Act and Rules - ptot.texas.gov

All Therapy Services (PT,OT,SP) 7 Plans of Care -Services must relate directly and specifically to a written treatment plan. -Must be established by: •Therapist who will provide the services (PT,OT, SP) •Physician/NPP -Must be •Signed •Dated •And have the professional's identification (e.g. MD, PT, OT)
